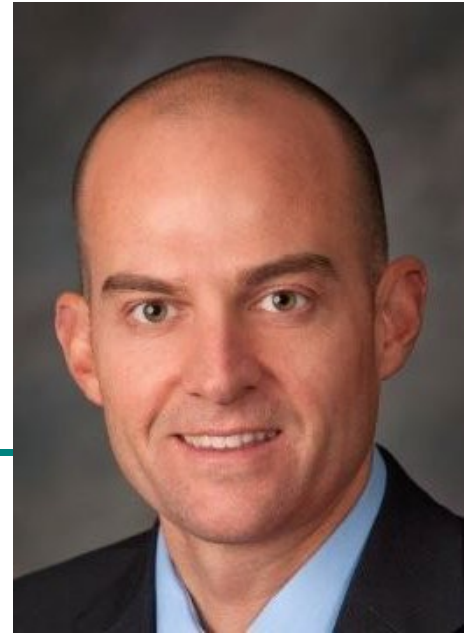


STEVE LOVELESS, MHA, FACHE, PCC
